It may also be used for other hard surface cleaning applications such as on concrete floors and walls, on food service surfaces and for industrial parts.

Application: Read Safety Data Sheet Carefully Before Handling. For best results, read and follow the manufacturer's instruction booklet supplied with your dish machine. Maintain water temperature between 140–160°F. Place dishes so they receive full force of the water spray. Where applicable, fill each dispenser cup in your machine, or place 1 ½ -2 tablespoons of D-13 in the bottom of your dishwasher. Add slightly more for pots and pans or hard water. For heavily soiled dishes, presoak for up to one hour using 4-6 ounces of D-13 per gallon of hot water. To improve rinsing and reduce spotting and film formation, use Arcot #9682 LAST DROP Rinsing & Drying Agent.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
